375g Butter


375g Dark Chocolate

500g Caster Sugar


225g Plain Flour

Enter the data into a spreadsheet it will look like this



To calculate the percentage of ingredient used, you will have to add the ingredients together and use this value for an absolute cell reference for the calculation. Format the answer to zero decimal places ie integer




This is the same spreadsheet showing

the formula. Note the use of the absolute cell reference.

Select the data and represent on a pie chart. Label the segments of the chart with the % ingredients. You will have to use the more data label options tab. This is what it will look like.
